

## to know about the Art Center

### 1 HISTORY & LOCATION

For 105 years, the Ann Arbor Art Center has been a vibrant and consistent resource for artists, students, art collectors and consumers living in or visiting the Ann Arbor area.

The Art Center serves as a highly visible epicenter of arts activity and cultural economic development in downtown Ann Arbor.

### 2 ART EDUCATION

The Art Center supports youth and adult artistic achievement through expert-led classes and immersive creativity camps featuring a wide range of mediums including:

- Ceramics
- Metal Jewelry
- Drawing & Painting
- Textiles & Fibers
- Digital Media
- And More!

Our NEW Art Reach Technology Lab blends traditional handmade art with digital illustration and computer animation.

### 3 SCHOLARSHIP & TUITION ASSISTANCE

The Art Center uses scholarship and tuition assistance programs, pop-up events, and off-site programming to take the arts to all parts of our community.

### 4 COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Families, retirees, school children, and people of all abilities and socioeconomic levels are able to engage in accessible arts activities that facilitate self-expression and artistic exploration.

### 5 ARTIST ENGAGEMENT

We provide Michigan's creative community of artists with accessible opportunities to make, exhibit, and sell their art. Most noticeably, this support happens through 117 Gallery Shop, our storefront retail space featuring work of over 175 artists.

### 6 EXHIBITION

The Art Center's 117 Gallery is our flexible, second-floor exhibition space showcasing work of local and national artists that reflects artistic virtuosity, enhances awareness of current events and social issues, and catalyzes community inspiration and dialogue.

Always innovating, our newest exhibition space is a street-facing micro gallery called the Aquarium Gallery.

### 7 FACILITY RENTALS

Community members and event planners use our beautiful three-story building as a site for celebrations, such as weddings and birthday parties, corporate meetings and other special events. We welcome this activity and offer packages of services to support flawless event execution.
