

Continuing Acrylic Painting

This course is for individuals who have taken The Basics of Acrylic Painting class and are ready to continue their learning of the medium. During the course, individuals will complete three paintings that each have a different "prompt or theme" as well as different styles/techniques of painting. This class allows the individual to explore their style of painting all while creating conceptual art.

Supplies Needed:

Basics of Acrylic Painting Supplies as well as additional supplies listed at bottom.

3- 16x20" or 18x24" Canvases or Canvas Panels (mix it up if you want, you don't have to buy all three in advance)

Palette (Paper plate, etc.) and a Water cup

1- 8x10" or similar size Sketchbook (can be one you already have, if you are purchasing a new one, I recommend one that says 80 lb. (or higher))

1- Titanium White Acrylic Paint

1- Burnt Umber Acrylic Paint

1- Ultramarine Blue Acrylic Paint

1- Cadmium Red Acrylic Paint

1- Cadmium Yellow Acrylic Paint

1- Hooker's Green Acrylic Paint

Optional Colors (many students in past classes have enjoyed having these)

1- Pthalo Blue Acrylic Paint

1- Yellow Ochre Acrylic Paint

1- Quinacridone Magenta Acrylic Paint

1- Set of Acrylic Paintbrushes (foundation sets are great, just make sure there is a range of sizes and types of brushes such as the brushes below-DOES NOT HAVE TO BE EXACT!)

- ☐ 2 angular brushes (sizes 1/2, 5/8)
- ☐ 2 flat brushes (sizes 2, 8)
- ☐ 2 filbert brushes (sizes 2,4)
- ☐ 3 round brushes (size 1, 2, 4)

Any other paint colors or brushes you may have, please bring! The more the merrier!

Each week I may have you bring a photograph or object to work from, be prepared to do so.

Additional Supplies:

- Glazing Medium (Liquitex or Golden brand, etc)
- Molding Paste or Impasto Gel
- Palette Knife
