Our Scholarship program has two "periods": Winter/Spring and Summer/Fall. Applicants must submit a completed application (Section 1-4 below) along with the required documentation on or before December 30th 2018 for Period 1, or June 16th 2019 for Period 2 as outlined below. Only complete applications will be considered. Grants are awarded on a first come, first served basis. Recipients will be notified the week prior to the start of classes. Each person that is awarded a scholarship will have access to one course/workshop per term as outlined below.

- ❖ **Materials fees are NOT included in the grant. Recipient must still purchase materials.**
- ❖ **Summer Creativity Camps are not included. There is a separate scholarship application for Summer Creativity Camps available in February of 2019.**
