Before the class begins you should make a drawing 5x7" that you would like to use for your class project. To give yourself an idea of what relief printmaking traditionally looks like, check out my [Pinterest Page](#). Make sure the drawing is not too detailed as it can be difficult to achieve with this process.

Materials List:

[Easy Cut Relief Block](#) (At most 5x7")

[linoleum cutter](#) ([Blick](#) also has a good option)

Printmaking Brayer (soft is best, [here is a Speedball option](#))

[Relief printmaking ink](#) (water soluble, 1 color is perfect)

[Relief printmaking paper](#)

[Strathmore 300 Series Printmaking Paper - 8" x 10", 40 Sheets](#)

Wooden spoon (or large metal)

Newprint or copy paper to do our test prints on

Pencil

Sketchbook

Tracing paper

Odds + ends:(optional) screws, thumb tacks, wire brushes
