Call for Proposals: Aquarium Gallery

Artists or Artist-led teams are invited to submit site-specific installation proposals for the Ann Arbor Art Center's Aquarium Gallery. The Aquarium is an experimental micro gallery designed to showcase site-specific installations that engage with a street-level audience. The street-facing gallery is comprised of a large window space measuring approximately 6' x 6' x 1' located near the corner of Ashley and Liberty streets in downtown Ann Arbor.

Submissions are accepted in any artistic discipline including mixed-media installation, sound, digital media, or performance, in addition to traditional modes of art-making such as painting, photography, textiles, ceramics, or sculpture. Previous successful projects have strongly considered the context and location of the Aquarium Gallery as well as the relationship of the work to the viewing audience.

Aquarium Gallery proposals are accepted on a rolling basis and are reviewed by the Art Center's Gallery team each month. Works must be original within the previous year and must not have been previously shown in any exhibition at the Ann Arbor Art Center.

Submission Requirements:

- Brief description of the proposed project. Include details of artwork materials, hardware necessary for installation and approximate dimensions.
- 3-5 images in any combination of reference, in-process, or sketches. Images should
