

# Intro to Oil Painting | Supply List

- Strathmore or Canson Mixed-Media paper or watercolor paper – minimum 9x12 (doesn't have to be new, if you already have – size is not of great importance)
- Sketchbook or paper, pencil or pen
- Oil paint: I recommend buying the highest quality paint you can afford. Artist-grade (as opposed to student grade) paints have much more pigment in them, so you get better coverage using less paint. Over the long run, it is probably the same cost as buying lower quality paint and needing to use more paint to get the same result. In my opinion Gamblin oil paint is the best value and quality. Gamblin 1980 is a bit cheaper but good quality for the price. \*These paints are optional but nice to have.
  - Cadmium Red
  - Alizarin Crimson\*
  - Ultramarine Blue
  - Cadmium Lemon
  - Yellow Ochre\*
  - Ivory Black
  - Titanium White
- Gamsol from Gamblin - this is odorless mineral spirits
- Brush cleaner - something like this: [www.amazon.com/Washer-Leak-Proof-Cleaner-Removable-Screen](http://www.amazon.com/Washer-Leak-Proof-Cleaner-Removable-Screen) (Optional but highly recommended).
- Paper Palette – Grey toned is best in my opinion - Jack Richeson Grey Matters Paper Palette-<https://www.amazon.com/Jack-Richeson-Matters-Palette-Sheets>
- Canvases or Canvas panels (Michaels brand will do) 8x10. We will most likely work on a larger piece in last few weeks of class but can wait to purchase that as we will discuss other options for substrates in class that you may wish to try.
- Palette knife – Will be using mostly for mixing paint.
- Minimum of 3 brushes in 3 different sizes (ex.: sizes 3,6, and 10). Those sizes are just examples as every manufacturer of brushes has different size. We are going to work small to begin with so keep them on the smaller side. Brushes also come in different shapes– filbert, bright, round and flat. I recommend getting the filberts. My favorite (reasonable priced) are Winsor Newton Monarch in sizes 10, 6, and 2
- “The Masters” Brush soap and conditioner – small size will do (Optional but highly recommend)
- Paper towels
- Baby wipes

You can find many of these items at Michaels (use your coupons for great savings) or Dick Blick, Cheap Joes or Jerry's Artarama are my suggested go-to online art supply stores.
