

# Intro to Acrylic Painting | Supply List

Instructor: Payton James

This class is designed for individuals who are new to acrylic painting and are interested in learning the foundations and improving their skills. You will begin by learning about tone, shades, color mixing and acrylic painting techniques.

During this course, you will complete projects that will enhance your understanding of the process of acrylic painting. Each week I may have you bring a photograph or object to work from, please be prepared to do so.

## Supplies Needed:

- 9x12" Canvas Paper Pad (similar to [THIS](#)) **OR** 9x12" Pre-Stretched Canvas (similar to [THIS](#))
- Palette
- 8x10" (or similar size) Sketchbook (can be one you already have, but if you are purchasing a new one I recommend that says 80lb or higher)
- Titanium White Acrylic Paint (1)
- Burnt Umber Acrylic Paint (1)
- Ultramarine Blue Acrylic Paint (1)
- Cadmium Red Acrylic Paint (1)
- Cadmium Yellow Acrylic Paint (1)
- Optional Colors** (many students have enjoyed having these):
  - Pthalo Blue Acrylic Paint
  - Yellow Ochre
  - Quinacridone Magenta Acrylic Paint
  - Hooker's Green Acrylic Paint
- 2 Angular Brushes (sizes 2, 5/8)
- 2 Bright Brushes (sizes 2, 4)
- 2 Flat Brushes (sizes 2, 8)
- 2 Filbert Brushes (sizes 2, 4)
- 3 Round Brushes (sizes 1, 2, 4)

\*Acrylic Brands of Paint: In order of lower quality to high quality; Liquidex Basics, Liquidex Professional, Daler-Rowney, Grumbacher. Please do not purchase Artist Loft brand or craft paint for any colors.

\*\*Foundation paint brush sets are great, please just be sure there is a range of sizes and types of brushes. They do not need to be exact to the list above.
