A2AC Announces The A2AC Gala: Thriving in Transition at Venue 4M

The event features a cocktail happy hour with a DJ and an artist creating an original work to be auctioned off later during a seated dinner and live auction.

"The impact of the Gala on our programming is incredible: Between classes, camps, and workshops, we offer hundreds of educational opportunities annually and are also able to make access to them possible for more than 100 scholarship recipients."

"While we are doing amazing work and punch well above our weight class, the A2AC has room to expand its programming, from exhibitions to education to camp. For 114 years, the A2AC has been the heart of what our community needs and wants, and we are excited to continue our work long into the future through sustainable, thoughtful growth."

During the cocktail happy hour, featuring custom creations from the Ann Arbor Distilling Company, attendees will have the chance to bid on a range of silent auction items, from practical to fanciful, including one-of-a-kind art and experiences. New for this year, the cocktail happy hour is available as a stand-alone opportunity to support the A2AC, with a ticket price of \$100.

The A2AC's dinner and live auction will offer a custom menu curated by Venue 4M's Chef, Thad Gillies, along with his selections for the accompanying wine pairing. Attendees will have the exciting experience of bidding against each other for items like an artist's studio evening with food, drinks, and discussion, a private event at The State Theater, incredible seats and suites for the University of Michigan and Detroit Tiger games, and rare wines. Tickets for the A2AC dinner are \$300 and include the cocktail happy hour.
