Overview: Behavioral Specialist & Classroom Support Aide

A2AC Art Camps serve children ages 5-12 years old. The Art Camps program includes both Creativity Camps, which exposes campers to a variety of materials and processes in both 2D and 3D projects, and Clay Camp, which teaches pottery skills and encourages the exploration of clay. The Behavioral Specialist & Classroom Support Aide will assist in supporting the social and emotional needs of campers. They will work with Administrative Staff and Camp Instructors to provide a positive and enriching experience for campers and a safe, welcoming Camp program.

This position begins on June 17th and ends on August 23rd. Strong preference will be given to applicants who are available to work full-time for the duration of the position. Applicants must be available to work 8:00am-4:30pm, Monday thru Friday. This position is a great opportunity to get a foot in the door. Successful Summer Camp Instructors may be considered for future Camp Seasons, or other classes and events.

Behavioral Specialist & Classroom Support Aide Duties

- Provides a safe, positive, creative environment for campers to thrive in
- Provides individualized support to campers to help them navigate social interactions and regulate emotions on an as needed basis
- Provides coverage as needed to the Lead Instructors and Assistant Instructors
- Coach/support relevant Camp Staff members on best practices of behavioral support
- Provides support and coverage to Administrative Staff
- Communicates with parents/guardians at the discretion of the Camp Director
- Assists campers with art projects throughout the day
- Assists with classroom management
- Prepares materials, organizes & distributes supplies
- Maintains order and cleanliness of the studios
- Assists with camper drop-off and pick-up

- Duties may include walking up and down stairs, standing, bending or leaning over, lifting up to 50 pounds, and working on one's feet most of the day
- Includes other duties related to day camp operations, as needed

Required Skills & Experience

- Prior experience working with children
- Bachelor's degree in Education, Psychology, Social Work, or a related field preferred
- Must have a background in behavior management techniques, as well as knowledge of developmental disabilities and behavior analysis
