Required Materials:

Tetra Pak Material

Students can gather this themselves. I will also bring some to share.



Plastic drypoint plates

The best type of plastic is 7mm (0.30") PETG, although other types can be used. The 8x12" size would be perfect for the 11x15" paper (see below). Start with a pack of 3.

Paper

The paper must have a decent weight to it, as it has to withstand being soaked in water. All my drypoint work has been done with Rives BFK, which I think is a good option. A 22x30" sheet can be cut into 11x15" quarter-sheets.

Etching Needle

You can also use a nail, a push pin, a sewing needle, or other alternatives, but it's nice to have a proper scribe.

The A2AC will provide all other supplies needed for the course.
